The deck plan of Sun Odyssey 439 is considered innovative due to the fact that it is uncluttered. The decks are kept clean and clear of any obstructions, all sailing functions being moved aft to the cockpit. This feature makes the 439 a short-handed cruiser, on which the crew can handle everything with great ease. There is enough free space around the folding cockpit table to make it a good place for spending quality time outside. The drop-down transom with integrated swim ladder creates a bathing platform which adds more fun to anchorages.
