Under sail, the Lagoon 500 handles with ease and transitions smoothly through different speeds and conditions. The catamaran handles wind well, but can lose some speed in a stiff wind. This loss of speed does not detract from the thrill of the sailing experience.

In fact, the 500's design allows for an ease of control even in poor weather circumstances and choppy water. These undemanding controls make the 500 a vessel perfect for even a novice sailor to operate without anxiety or difficulty.

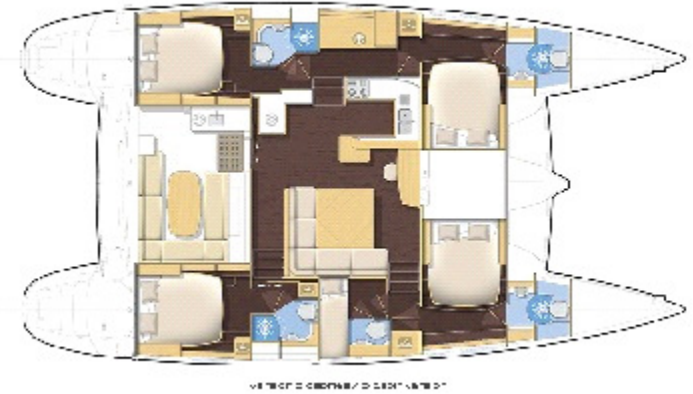
