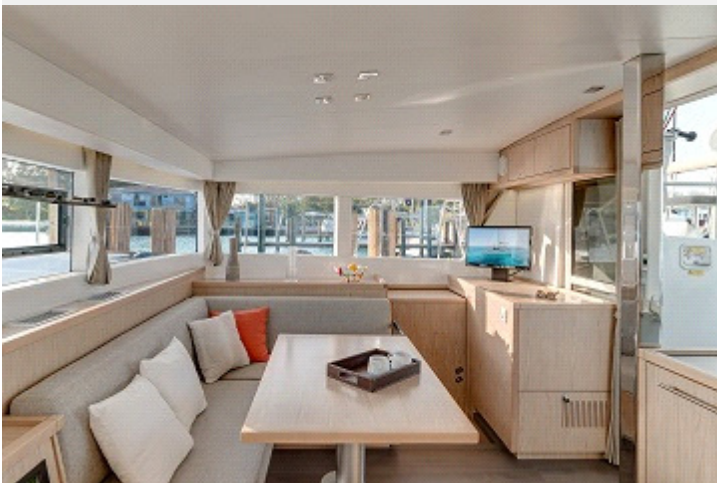


# Lagoon 39 ""

- Broad sidedecks, with recessed deck hatches



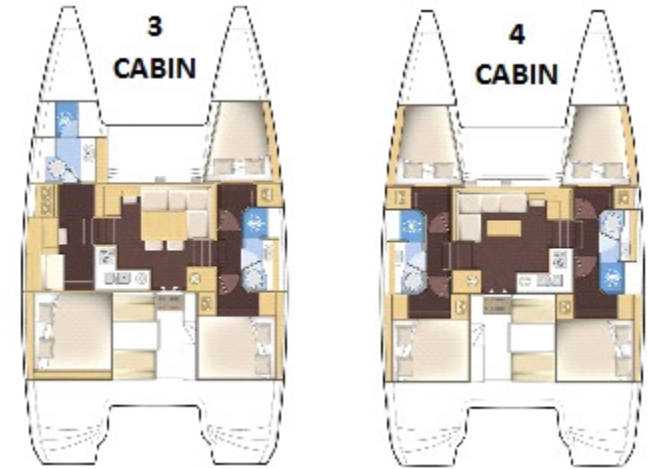
